<b>Ministerial Orders Approved</b>	<b>Statutory Authority &amp; Regulatory Plan Listing</b>
<p><b>Cable Television Regulations, 1986, amendments (SOR/97-259; SOR/97-260)</b></p> <p>The first amendments change the Public Notice referred to in subsection 10(2) of the Regulations, in order to establish new distribution and linkage requirements for programming services.</p> <p>These amendments, which were prepublished in the Canada Gazette, Part I on March 1, 1997, come into effect May 12, 1997.</p> <p>The second change repeals subsection 18(5) to (7). Prepublished in the Canada Gazette, Part I on March 22, 1997, this amendment is effective on December 31, 1997. This change provides that capital expenditures incurred by a licensee after August 31, 1996 will not be recoverable through an increase in the licensee's basic monthly fee pursuant to subsection 18(6) of the Regulations.</p> <p>Contact: Allan J. # Ministerial Orders Approved

## Statutory Authority & Regulatory Plan Listing

### Canadian Chicken Marketing Quota Regulations, 1990, amendment (SOR/97-261)

This amendment establishes the 1997 periodic allocation for the period from July 6, 1997 to August 30, 1997, for producers who market chicken in interprovincial or export trade. Schedule II to the Regulations is replaced with a new schedule outlining limits for production of chicken for the period.

The new production subject to quotas (in kilograms of live weight) for each province are as follows: Ontario, 51,680,000 kg; Quebec, 45,388,409 kg; Nova Scotia, 6,082,000 kg; New Brunswick, 4,238,818 kg; Manitoba, 6,234,686 kg; Prince Edward Island, 580,794 kg; Saskatchewan, 3,710,699 kg; Alberta, 14,547,171 kg; and Newfoundland, 2,442,177 kg. The total for the period is 134,904,754 kilograms.

Under Column III, "Production Subject to Periodic Export Quotas (in Live Weight) (Kilograms)", the amount for Nova Scotia for the period is 100,000 kg and for Alberta is 489,796 kg.
