<p>Government Property Traffic Regulations, amendment (SOR/97-277, OIC 1997-792)</p> <p>The amendments to the Regulations provide for the administrative arrangements necessary for the operation and enforcement of the Regulations on the Confederation Bridge. They amend those provisions of the Regulations which identify a linkage to provincial legislation governing highway traffic.</p> <p>Specifically, the amendments establish a link between the laws of the Province of Prince Edward Island and the Regulations. The amendments also provide a definition of "Confederation Bridge".</p> <p>The regulations were prepublished in the Canada Gazette, Part I, On April 26, 1997; no comments were received.</p> <p>Contact: Christian H. National Energy Board Cost Recovery Regulations, amendment (SOR/97-271)

The amendment adds Express Pipeline Ltd. to Part I of Schedule I to the Regulations, effective May 23, 1997.

Schedule I lists small, intermediate and large oil pipeline companies for the purpose of establishing the amount the pipeline company pays under the National Energy Board's cost recovery scheme.

Express Pipeline is a new oil pipeline company that will come into operation in the spring of 1997. It will have an annual cost of service in excess of \$10,000,000 and this amendment will ensure that it is treated the same as other large oil pipeline companies.
