<b>Exempt from Pre-Publication and Approved</b>	<b>Statutory Authority</b>
<p><b>Pulp &amp; Paper Regulations, amendment (SOR/99-166, OIC 1999-586)</b></p> <p>The amendment replaces the expression “three years” with “four years” in section 32 of the Regulations.</p> <p>The new section, under the Environmental Effects Monitoring Studies portion of the Regulation, now reads:</p> <p>“32. The operator shall provide the Minister with the interpretive report and supporting data on the second and each successive environmental effects monitoring studying within <b>four years</b> after the submission of the interpretive report and supporting data on the previous study.”</p> <p>The amendment comes into effect on April 1, 1999.</p>	<p><i>Fisheries Act</i>, section 37</p> <p>To be published in Canada Gazette 14, 1999</p>
